Mid-Week Missions Challenge Ideas

Missions Prayer Circle – Use the **Mission: Possible! Prayer Guide** to lead your congregation through praying for Church of God missions worldwide! Read each regional page, then pray ten minutes for each of the six regions.

Missions Care Package – Find out from the missionaries you support what they miss from home. Bring items, pray over them, and pack the items to send to your missionaries. (Note: the cost of shipping to many parts of the world far exceeds the cost of the items you will send. Also make sure you know the country's import restrictions.)

Missionary Moment – Ask your missionaries to send a short video greeting and prayer requests. Encourage your congregation to pray for them.

Missionary Encouragement – Gather the congregation and ask people to video a prayer or a message of encouragement to your missionaries. Send or post the videos as one document, or send them individually over the next several weeks.

Missionary Care Greetings – Gather the congregation and sign one card or have multiple cards with individual messages of encouragement and mail them. If your missionaries have children, find out their names and have the children in your congregation send them a personal note.

Local Partner Appreciation – Surprise the local organizations that your church partners with— food banks, after school clubs, shelters, etc. Send them a video greeting or thank you card for their service to your community. Just because they are in your community doesn't mean they don't need encouragement!

Ministry Experience Celebration – There hasn't been much travel for a while due to the pandemic, but you can still celebrate your church's short-term ministry experiences. Have past participants give their testimonies and share their photos. When travel possibilities return, you may have a congregation full of eager laborers for the field! 🌍
