- 1—Congo (DRC):** Please pray for Rev. Noela, leader of the Church of God in the Democratic Republic of Congo.
- 2—Spain:** Pray for 3W missionaries Alejandro and Carmen De Francisco as they continue to lead the En Mi Lugar church and the Multiply Madrid Network to plant churches all around Spain.
- 3—Costa Rica:** Give thanks for the years of ministry service Pastor José has given to the church in Los Guido. As he steps aside for health reasons, pray for his son Josué, who officially takes over ministry duties today.
- 4—Japan:** Pray for missionaries Mike and Makiko Boyle and the Hagiya Church of God. Pray also for the students in the English learning classes.
- 5—Latin America:** Pray for the Interamerican leadership team as they explore options for church planting, theological training, and providing support to churches in crisis around the region.
- 6—Hurricane Season:** Pray for those impacted by natural disasters. Pray specifically for those today who will be affected by hurricanes, cyclones, and typhoons to come, but also those affected in recent years.

- 13—Nations in Distress:** Today we pray specifically for nations experiencing turmoil—from illness, famine, war, political unrest. Ask God to bring his peace, grace, mercy, and healing to the nations.
- 14—Honduras:** Give thanks for the church’s entrepreneurial training school, which continues to raise up disciple makers supported by small businesses.
- 15—Spain:** Give thanks for En Mi Lugar congregation in Madrid, which recently celebrated its second anniversary. Praise God for the lives touched and the impact made over these last two years.
- 16—Global Strategy:** Pray for the project managers and advocates as they work to fulfill the goals of the projects.
- 17—Trinidad & Tobago:** Pray for the national church and for the leader, Allister Bhola.
- 18—Asia-Pacific:** Pray for the virtual Asia Pacific Conference to be held this week. Pray for all the technical and connectivity issues to be slight throughout the week of meetings.

**22—Zimbabwe:** Pray for the national church and leaders Rev. Dzingai Guni and his wife Gloria.

**23—Antigua and Barbuda:** Pray for the five congregations and for the national leader, Ivor Davis, as he walks alongside the churches and leaders.

**24—United Nations Day:** Today we pray Psalm 22:27 over the nations of the world, that “all the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations will bow before Him” (NIV).
